

Extended Housing FAQs

Please unload your belongings on the side walk in front of your hall and move your car to the parking lot.

Special Note:

Please remember that space is very limited in extended housing. Be sure you bring only what you need at the start. Once you talk with the rest of your roommates you may be able to bring a few more items.

What is Extended housing?

Extended housing provides temporary housing for students who turn in a late contract and are unable to be assigned a permanent space. These rooms are still located within the Residence halls. Rooms used for extended housing can accommodate 6 students. These spaces are completely secure and lockable.

Where will I be able to do laundry ?

Since extended housing is still in the residence halls, you will have full access to the laundry facilities located in the basement of your hall. You can use quarters or your ID card.

What about long distance phone calls?

You will need to use your cell phone. We do not have landline phones in any of our residence hall rooms.

Where do I go to get my mail?

Those living in extended housing will need to pick their mail up at the front desk of their hall. They will need to bring their student ID in order to claim their mail. Students may also mail letters in the appro-

priate bin located in the lobby of their hall.

How long will it be before I am assigned to a permanent space?

Some students may be reassigned within a few days of the Aug. 29th move-in date. Others may be in extended housing for much of the first semester. You will receive a letter at your hall address when you have been reassigned to a permanent space. Students will be reassigned to permanent spaces based on contract date order.

Should I bring all my personal belongings?

We advise against bringing all of your personal belongings and large items, such as TV's. Due to space constraints, it would be advisable to pack light and bring items on an "as needed" basis.

What furniture is provided?

Each room will have 3 sets of bunk beds, 6 dressers, a table & 6 chairs, 3 refrigerators, and 2 TV/computer boxes. Numbers may vary slightly. All extended housing spaces are equipped with cable TV and internet access.

Lofts are not allowed in extended housing spaces. Nor are they needed in any of our other residence halls. The new furniture comes with loft kits.

Will the cost of the room be different for those living in extended housing?

Students remaining in Extended housing after the 15th of each month, starting with September, will receive small monetary credits to their University accounts to help compensate for not being in a permanent assignment.

What about parking my car?

Who should I contact if I need help solving a problem?

Since you are still in the residence halls and will be assigned to a wing, you will have an Resident Assistant (RA). In the event you need help, your RA will be there for support as well as the Hall Manager and the Residence Life staff.
