Notable Rules

- Overtime

Both teams will select a player to attempt 1 penalty shot
After 3 kickers if the game is still tied it will end in a tie.

- Off sides

- A player from the attacking team is behind the last defender (not including the goalie) before the ball is kicked to them
- A whistle will be blown if the attacking player behind the defender touches the ball

- Hand Balls

- A ball that hits a players hand will result in an indirect kick for the opposite team
- The ball must completely cross the boundary lines to be out of play.

Notable Rules Cont....

- Only indirect kicks will be issued unless the foul occurs in the penalty box if this happens the result is a direct kick from the penalty mark.
- An indirect kick is signaled by the ref lifting his/her left arm until the ball is touched by a second player.
- A player shall be penalized if he/she:
 - Kicks, strikes, trips, pushes, or holds an opponent (or attempts).
 - Intentionally carries, strikes, or propels the ball with the hands or arms.
 - Intentionally obstructs an opponent when not playing the ball.
 - Uses a slide tackle or high kick.
 - Interferes or impedes with the goal keeper in possession of the ball in the goalie area.
- Time is continuous.
- Both teams are allowed 2 timeouts of 1 minute each per game

Last of notable rules

- Make your positioning pertinent to the flow of the game
 - You are part of the game, if the ball hits you, play on!
- Scorekeepers
- Time will always go by, the center official needs your help to watch the game.
- Be another set of eyes for off sides and possession after ball out of bounds
