Chair Witte- I feel student should have been involved from the start.

Levendoski- I agree

Heinselman- I don't understand what Senate determines what is involvement and what isn't.

President Bendix- Who initiated the process?

Heinselman- I initiated the process.

Chair Brock- I hope that we can get passed this.
