

Student Affairs and Academic Services Committee Minutes

Monday, February 9th 2009 at 6:00 pm, Student Senate Office

- I. Meeting Called to order at 6:00 pm. Minutes from the February 2nd and February 9th meetings will be reviewed next week (February 16th)
- II. Tyler Halverson was absent (excused), all others present. No guests
- III. Chair moved Skateboard Policy forward in the agenda for discussion. Cited was UWS chapter 18.06 (29) and UWRF Administrative Policy Paper 30. It was decided that the committee would look into the possibility of revising Policy Paper 30 to change the rules regarding when and where skateboards could be used.
- IV. The UWRF Main Page is currently completed with phase 1 of its redesign, with phase 2 to occur later in the semester, probably April. The implementation of a single log-in service for students on campus is a possibility that was discussed inside Faculty Senate as well.
- V. There is no update for the University Center Pub idea. There is a meeting Tuesday February 10th with members of Student Health Services, Jordan Harshman is attending.
- VI. The committee extensively discussed matters concerning the administering of a new survey. Cited was a list of results from a past survey, though there was some question of what body on campus put out the survey; said survey garnered approximately 515 responses. Members were tasked with searching past Senate minutes from the 2006-2007 academic year to determine whether the survey found was put out by the Student Affairs and Academic Services committee or a separate body. Discussed were multiple ideas for administering the survey, how to create the new survey, and whether to create a location for students to direct issues and complaints to senate (a comment box, for example). Kayla Godes volunteered to attempt contact with other UW system schools to study possible advertising strategies to better spread the word about a survey at River Falls. Tabling in the future was also discussed.
- VII. Discussed briefly was the possibility of working with Dustin Pfundheller and the Finance Department with the Student Savings Club card idea, specifically with advertisement and busywork. It was decided that the issue would be brought up again at the next meeting. Jordan Harshman moved to adjourn, Kurtis Drager seconded, all were in favor, none opposed or abstained. Meeting was adjourned at 6:44 pm.
