

## Student Affairs and Academic Services Committee Minutes

Monday, February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2009 at 6:00 pm, Student Senate Office

- I. Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm
- II. All members were present, no guests presented themselves
- III. Missing minutes from last semester were discussed, outstanding unapproved minutes were approved.
- IV. Chair had no report for this week's meeting.
- V. Motion to revise the skateboard policy was not placed on Tuesday's Senate agenda because there was second thoughts over whether the revisions were done appropriately. It was determined that this issue does not need to be handled immediately.
- VI. Tabling with the rest of Student Senate was discussed; specifically discussed was what material from the committee should be displayed on the table. Some members did not approve of sharing a table with Senate, so the possibility of setting up a table just for S.A.A.S. was discussed. Senate tabling dates are the 23<sup>rd</sup> through 25<sup>th</sup> of March.
- VII. The On-Campus Pub was discussed. It was decided that the committee should look further into the issue. The idea was brought up to create an ad hoc sometime in the future to look into the issue as well, though nothing officially has been decided.
- VIII. The committee evaluated the possibility of a Travel Abroad requirement for graduation, and decided that it is impractical to demand that students travel for a semester without evidence of proper financial aid available to those students. Therefore, committee unanimously agreed against the issue unless further evidence was discovered that would make travelling abroad more cost-effective.
- IX. The committee was in favor of relocating the meeting from the current location in the Senate office to a new location in the Mississippi River Room, or another room inside the University Center.
- X. Meeting was adjourned at 6:40 pm, Central Standard Time (GMT –6 hours)
