- I. Meeting called to order at 6:00 pm.
- II. Patrick Okan, Kayla Godes, Katy Van Putten, Jordan Harshman, Kurtis Drager, David Peschman (guest), Cindy Bendix (partial)(guest), Spencer Gansluckner (partial)(guest).
- III. Minutes approved, motion to approve made by Kurtis, seconded by Jordan – passed unanimously.
- IV. Chair Report: Only one meeting left this semester!
- V. When last checked, whine line had one e-mail which the chair responded to. Committee approved response typed by Katy, to be sent to concerned student who sent e-mails last week.
- VI. No new flyers would be printed for the Wednesday table, suggestions for candy were taken. It was decided that new “survey slips” should be typed up, for the smoking ban instead of the on-campus pub since the on-campus pub would be on the Student Senate ballot as a referendum. Reminder was made to senators **NOT** to discuss the elections or individual candidates while sitting at the table.
- VII. Chair left the meeting to locate information on the Student Senate budget for next year, specifically the SAAS budget. Was unable to find immediately. Later, left meeting again and was able to identify most of the items being funded in the 2009-2010 year. Tasks assigned to the 09-10 SAAS committee include; Student Savings Cards, Campus Safety Walk, Care Packages for deployed military personnel, and advertising for ZimRide (an online version of the Ride Board).

Committee suggested that next year’s senate look into the on-campus smoking ban, as well as continue work with the on-campus pub if it passes referendum. It was also suggested and agreed upon that next year’s SAAS committee should work to revise the form to rate faculty.
- VIII. The final meeting of SAAS will be short, expect some sort of “treat,” ideas for possible activities were tossed around but no agreement was reached.
